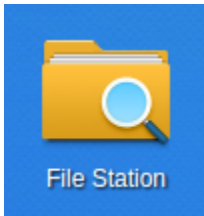


Setting up Permissions for access to Time Machine Backup Destination

Notes:

Time Machine on the mac computer must have backed up to the destination folder at least once, as the Time Machine application creates the folder for which you need to set permissions.

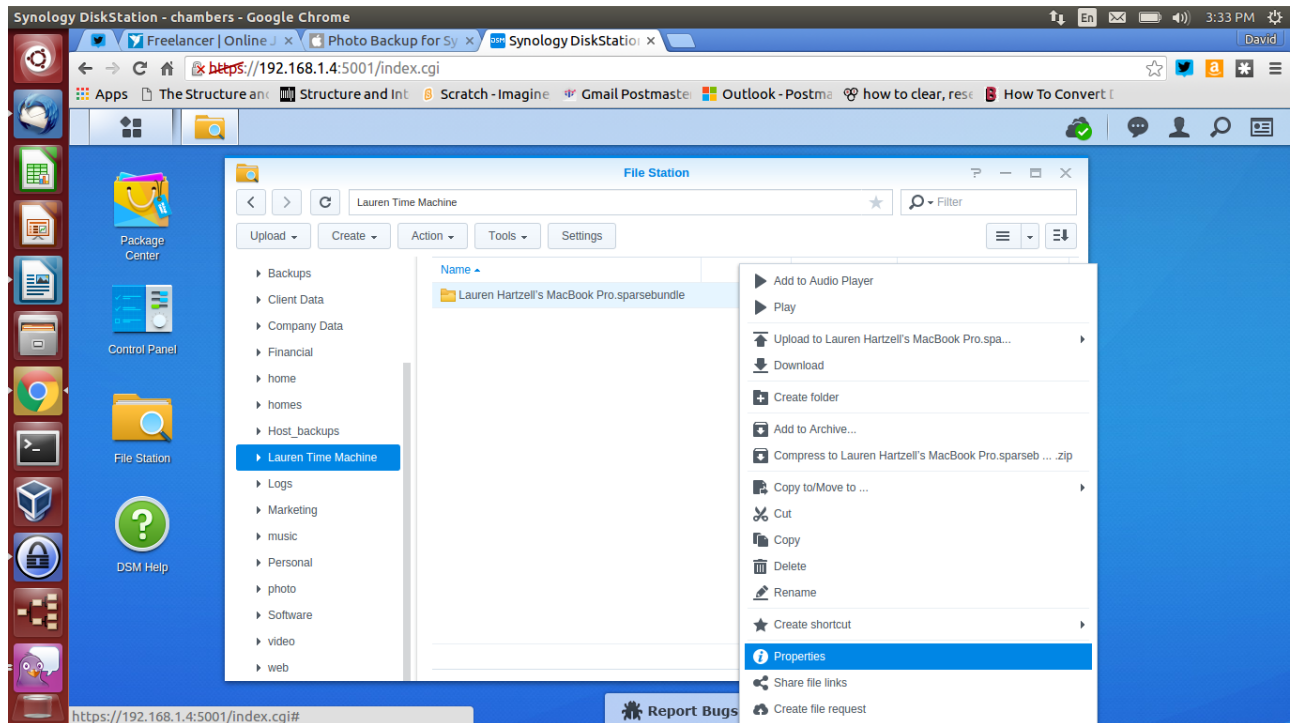
- 1. Log into the Synology NAS**
- 2. Open File Station**



- 3. Click on the Time Machine backup folder**

(Scroll down to Next Page)

4. Right-Click on the Time Machine archive folder, and click on “Properties”



5. Click on “Permissions”

6. Click “Advanced Options”

7. Click on “Exclude Inherited Permissions”

8. Click “Create”

9. Select the User or Group who should have access to that Time Machine folder.

1. Give that user or group read & write permissions and click OK.
